

**Thrombosis Committee, Hemophilia and Thrombosis Research Society:
Priorities and Some Ideas for 2005-2006:**

- 1.** Successful contributions to the HTRS April Symposium in Chicago, with ideas for continuing this symposium in the future (q1-2 yrs, locations).
- 2.** Establish a clinical thrombosis registry.
- 3.** Repeat the research competition for donated funds; follow progress of this year's winners.
- 4.** Develop further a relationship with NATT (speaker exchange? HTRS web site summaries of major thrombotic disorders).
- 5.** Working alliance with the TMH network (foster clinical trials in thrombosis, encourage young investigators).
- 6.** Encourage targeted responses to RFAs (e.g., NHLBI May RFA concerning the post-phlebotic syndrom: t-PA vs low MW heparin).
- 7.** A "white paper," identifying major thrombotic conditions with which we are concerned, and studies needed for each of these conditions.
- 8.** Help develop a consensus hypercoagulability panel.
- 9.** Position statement regarding family testing and counseling regarding thrombophilia.
- 10.** Help develop a consensus diagnostic imaging pathway (including cardiac and transcranial bubble studies).
