

## HEMATOLOGY FACULTY POSITION

Duke Hematology is a Division within the Department of Medicine in the Duke University Health System that has a primary focus on non-malignant Hematology. Our clinical and research programs are expanding, and we are actively seeking two new junior to mid-career faculty members interested in being part of a vibrant, dynamic program. Key clinical and research strengths within Duke Hematology include clinical and research programs in Sickle Cell Disease; Hemostasis & Thrombosis; Apheresis; and Myeloproliferative Neoplasms.

We are seeking faculty members with an emphasis on clinical effort, but we are also interested in bringing in faculty with an interest in building clinical and translational research programs to complement basic research programs within the Division. Inpatient and outpatient responsibilities are included in the positions, including opening a new clinical program at Duke Regional Hospital. Educational opportunities are available working with fellows in the Duke Hematology/Oncology fellowship program, and interns and residents within the Internal Medicine Residency Training Program.

Unique opportunities available through Duke Hematology include direct involvement with the clinical laboratory services (Coagulation and Platelet Antibody Laboratories, and the Transfusion Service); direct supervision of apheresis services; a robust clinical research program; access to the Hemostasis & Thrombosis Core Laboratory in support of research efforts; interface with Pediatrics with a transition clinic for patients with sickle cell disease; interdisciplinary collaborations (cardiovascular surgery; maternal fetal medicine) and an expanding clinical program throughout the Health System.

Candidates must have an MD degree and board certification in Medicine with board certification/board eligibility in Hematology.
