### Program Highlights

We are a federally designated Hemostasis & Thrombosis Center that cares for approximately 1000 children with hemostasis-thrombosis problems each year. Our Pediatric Hemostasis-Thrombosis Services include:

The curriculum is tailored to matriculating fellows' career goals: 50% Clinical (2/3 outpatient) and 50% Research. Elective opportunities include:

- Adult Hemophilia
- Adult Thrombosis
- Others

### Eligibility Criteria

- Must be eligible/obtain an Ohio medical license
- Completed Pediatrics, Internal Medicine, or IM/ Pediatrics Residency
- Completion of Pediatric Hematology/Oncology Fellowship (or fellowship in a Hemostasis-Thrombosis-related discipline) prior to matriculation
- Board Eligible or Certified in Pediatric Hematology/Oncology (or related discipline) prior to matriculation
- If not a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, have a current J-1 or J-2 VISA
