Applicants will be recruited to care for patients with benign hematological conditions in the outpatient setting and participate in the hospital consultative hematology service as well as have a portion of their time dedicated to clinical or translational research and teaching. Candidates will be expected to teach and mentor trainees of Emory University School of Medicine.

Appointment at the Assistant Professor, Associate Professor or Professor academic rank at Emory University will be commensurate with experience, training and achievements. Successful candidates will have a clinical appointment at Emory University Hospital and Emory University Hospital–Midtown.
