The Hemostasis & Thrombosis Research Society (HTRS) is accepting applications from junior faculty-level physician scientists and postdoctoral researchers to attend the **HTRS 2025 Research Colloquium**, March 11-12, 2025, at the Loews Coronado Bay Resort in Coronado, CA. This non-CME event will take place prior to the HTRS 2025 Scientific Symposium.

About the HTRS 2025 Research Colloquium

The Colloquium is a 1.5-day, in-person workshop designed for early-stage investigators (“ESIs”) working to build sustainable academic research careers in hemostasis and thrombosis. The target audience for this workshop is physician scientists and/or postdoctoral, discovery-based researchers who hold junior faculty positions at academic institutions in the U.S. and Canada.

The goals of the Colloquium are to:

- Foster connections among ESIs leading to collaborative research projects in hemostasis and thrombosis
- Provide ESIs with continuing professional education, mentoring, and career development support to build sustainable, long-term research careers in hemostasis and thrombosis

Applicant Eligibility Requirements

The Colloquium is open to 30 MDs, DOs, MD/PhDs, or PhDs interested in hemostasis and thrombosis **within seven (7) years** of completing medical fellowship or doctoral education/training. If applications exceed 30, preference will be given to applicants who have not previously attended an HTRS Research Colloquium.

Applicants will be notified by HTRS of acceptance via email by the end of January 2025.

Expenses and Travel

HTRS will cover economy airfare, ground transportation, and meals on travel days up to a maximum of \$750 USD. Accepted attendees will also receive a sleeping room for two (2) nights at the Loews Coronado Bay Resort. Any additional nights of pre- and post-Colloquium accommodations, including nights to attend the HTRS 2025 Scientific Symposium, must be arranged and paid for by the attendee directly with the resort. HTRS will also provide accepted applicants with waived registration for the [HTRS 2025 Scientific Symposium](#), which will be held from March 13-15, 2025, at the same venue.



Education Design

The scientific content and agenda for the Colloquium are designed by the HTRS 2025 Research Colloquium Planning Committee, comprising HTRS members with expertise in clinical science, basic science, translational science, and industry-based research.

The Planning Committee ensures that the Colloquium is free from commercial bias. Although the Colloquium is a non-CME activity, HTRS follows best practices in CME education for planning and coordinating educational content.
